

The postage drawer

The postmaster needs exactly four stamps worth a total of 20 credits. Use at least one stamp of each available value. You may use a value more than once.

Stamp design	Value
Snowflake	3 credits
Robin	5 credits
Fir tree	7 credits

Exactly FOUR stamps. Exactly TWENTY credits. At least ONE of EACH design.

How many ROBIN stamps are needed? Record that count as STAMP.

Need a nudge? Use clue 1 in the separate hint guide. Asking for a hint is part of the game.

What's in the full game?

A snowstorm has scrambled the final holiday mail run. Sort the curious parcels and recover the dispatch code for one very important delivery.

10-page game booklet, five-page hint guide, Letter and A4, offline hint checker and optional invitation/certificate.

Suggested ages 10+, 2–6 players, 25–45 minutes estimated. Not yet timed with representative groups.

Sample solution

One of each totals $3 + 5 + 7 = 15$. The fourth stamp must be another 5-credit robin. Two robin stamps are used. STAMP = 2.

Printing

Print single-sided, actual size, on ordinary paper. Black and white works. No cutting, locks or props required. The full kit's start page lists the essential pages.
